Zimbabwe – on behalf of the African group

- Appreciate technical discussion for emissions reduction and emissions across different regions
- Investment mechanisms that can help developing countries
- Dialogues were not attended as there was a low presence of Africa
- Financing technology and capacity building – increase mitigation and adaptation
- Support to the developing countries for NDCs
- This dialogue can be used constructively to take actions

Samoa – on behalf of the SIDS

- Youth were not able to join due to double booking, so logistic arrangements must be strengthened so the process is inclusive
- Aspirations must not be under estimated
- Mitigation program must do much more
- Key findings and solutions from the cities and other programs must be emphasised to enable capacity building
- SIDS
- Themes must focus on high energy intensive sectors

European Union – on behalf of G77 and China

- Respond to the mitigation and the global stocktake
- Solutions must find the key barriers so they can be addressed
- Global dialogues – balanced participation and balanced presentation

South Korea

- Be clear on our mandate
- Mandate can be interpreted differently, e.g., ‘progress’

Chile – on behalf of Latin America
