# TIERED PRICING MODEL AND GLOBAL EQUITY

## **Tiered Pricing Alignment**

Pricing tiers align with World Bank income classifications to ensure affordability across different regions.

## **Cross-Subsidisation Model**

Higher-income participants subsidise access for learners from low- and middle-income countries.

## **Inclusivity and Excellence**

The model balances rigorous academic standards with inclusive access for all learners worldwide.

## **Global Shared Responsibility**

Fosters a sense of shared responsibility among participants to contribute and benefit equally.

## Applied and Relevant Learning

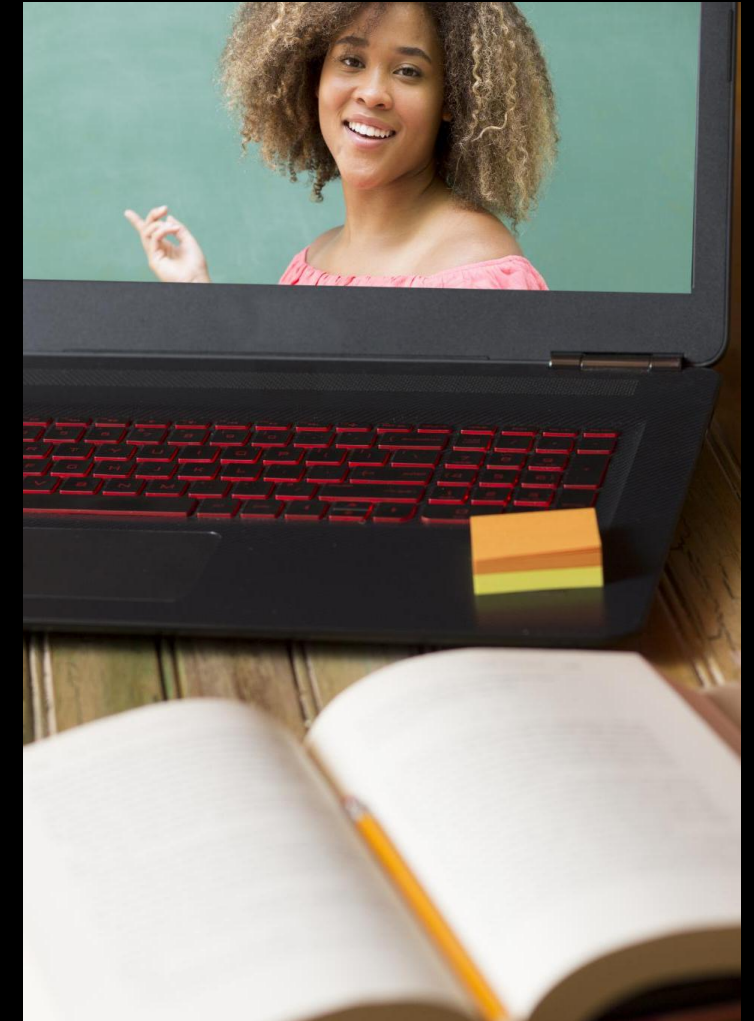
Programmes focus on applied skills and local relevance to ensure practical outcomes and contextual understanding.

# 01

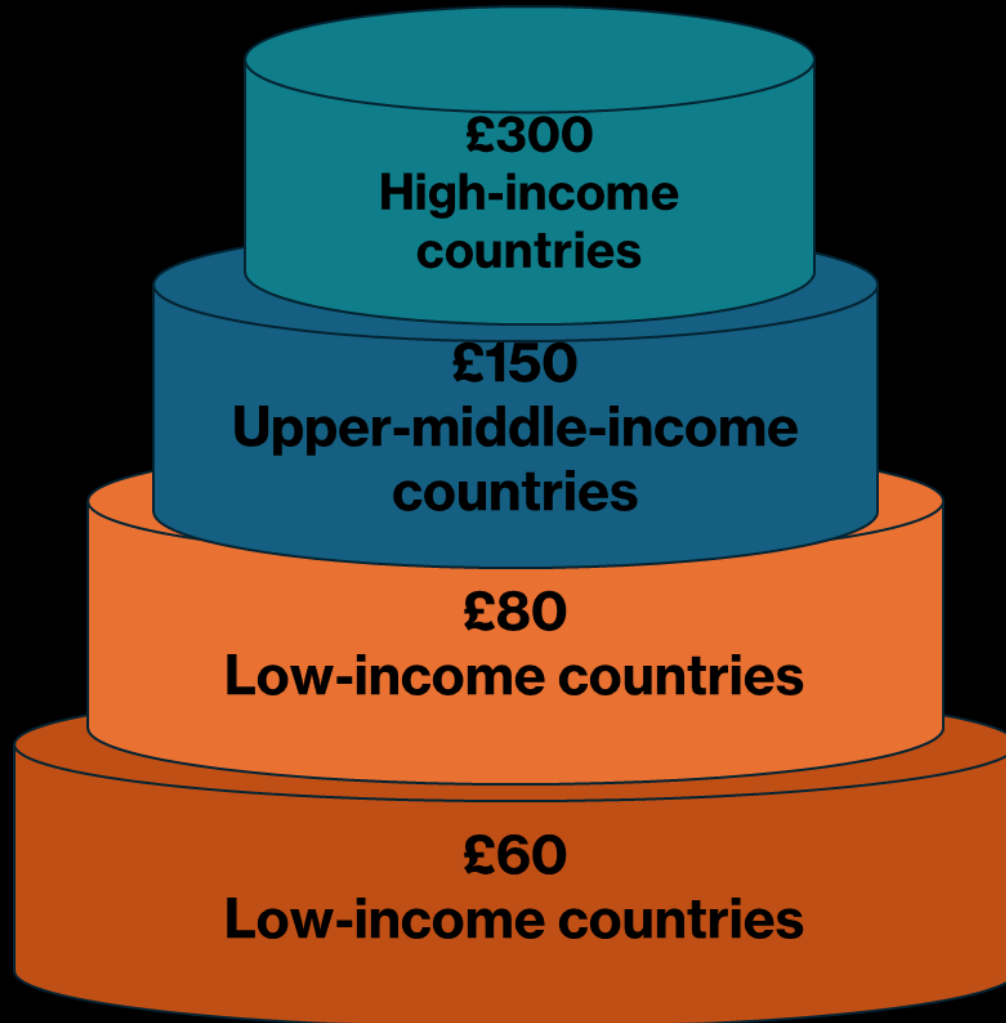
Programme fees are set according to the learner's country of residence, reflecting differences in income levels and ability to pay.

# 02

This ensures learners are not excluded due to geography or economic circumstances.

Higher-income participants help cross-subsidise access for learners in low- and middle-income countries, creating a sustainable and inclusive learning community



## FEE TIERS (PER MODULE)

- Low-income countries: £60
- Lower-middle-income countries: £80
- Upper-middle-income countries: £150
- High-income countries: £300
